

What does EDIReader do when it finds invalid EDI syntax?

When EDIReader discovers a syntax error in the EDI it is parsing, it throws a subclass of SAXException just as an XML SAX parser would. Specifically, it throws an EDIException, which is a subclass of SAXException. Generally speaking, the EDIException carries details of segment number and field number, along with context-specific information on the error condition.
